DANIEL (CONTINUED)

LUCY

(CONTINUED)

DANIEL

I mean, at work you are special for reasons I'm just starting to figure out. But... to me you're special in a different way.

LUCY

So ... wait, I was your "job"?

DANIEL

Yes. Well, no. I mean, not exactly.

Lucy turns back to the ocean, slightly bewildered.

DANIEL (CONTINUED)

It'll make sense to you. Soon. I promise.

Daniel looks at Lucy, but she holds her gaze forward. He begins to move in front of her, and can see she's shed a tear. He begins to speak, but then holds himself back. Lucy doesn't break her gaze from the ocean.

LUCY

Daniel... I... don't understand. What's happening to me? What is all of this.

DANIEL

In time I'll tell you everything I know.

Lucy eyes him with a slight suspicion.

LUCY

What happens if I don't like what I hear?

DANIEL

I hope that won't be a problem.

LUCY

Daniel... I feel out of control. I need some perspective here.

DANIEL

I'm trying. But I need to understand everything before I lay it out. I need everything to be perfect.

(CONTINUED)

Lucy finally gives in, albeit confused, and settles her head on Daniel's chest, so that they are holding each other slightly. In the distance, the horizon begins to turn a bit darker, and clouds start rolling in.

LUCY

You should work on your weather cues. That looks like rain.

INT. BEDROOM - NIGHT - CONTINUOUS
